

• The Appropriations Act:

- * Each Appropriations Act is applicable for one fiscal year (July 1 –June 30)
- * Organized by Part IA & Part IB
- IA: Appropriation of funds and FTEs
- IB: Provisos Temporary laws for the budget that direct the expenditure of funds in Part IA. https://www.scstatehouse.gov/sess124 2021-2022/appropriations2022/ta22ndx.php

Fund Types:

- * General Funds (State Funds)
- * Other Funds (Revenues)
 - Earmarked Accrued interest goes to the General Fund
 - Restricted Accrued interest remains in the fund
- * Federal Funds (Federal Grants)
