



- Lapse of Appropriations: October 1 17, 2013
- Continuing Resolution (CR) through January 15, 2014
 - Final appropriations approved January 18, 2014
- FY 2014 Appropriations (\$M):
 - FY 2014 Congressional Request Site EM Total + \$1.209B
 - FY 2014 Omnibus Site Total + \$1.255B
 - Delta (Omnibus vs Congressional Request) SRS +\$46M
- FY 2015: Continuing Resolution through December 11, 2014
