- Have a working knowledge of how their agency operates.

PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS

- Attend all program courses.
- Commit to fully participate in all program components.
- Complete all assignments between classes.
- Meet with executive level staff in their agency.

AGENCY REQUIREMENTS

- Support its participant throughout the program by:
 - Allowing time for completion of self-paced coursework.
 - Ensuring availability of an executive level staff member to meet with participant (one time).
